

Youth Driver Eligibility Form – 410 Sprint Car Division

1. Purpose

This section establishes the mandatory criteria, evaluation procedures, and insurance requirements for permitting a **15-year-old driver** (“Minor Driver”) to participate in any 410-sprint car competition sanctioned by Skagit Speedway. These standards exist to ensure the safety of the Minor Driver, other competitors, officials, and spectators, and to maintain compliance with insurance and legal obligations.

2. Eligibility Requirements

A Minor Driver may be considered for participation only if all of the following criteria are met:

- **Age Verification:** Driver must be at least 15 years old on the date of the event and provide government-issued identification.
- **Parental/Guardian Consent:** Both legal guardians must sign all required waivers, releases, and indemnification agreements.
- **Medical Clearance:** A current medical examination from a licensed physician confirming physical and cognitive fitness for high-speed motorsports.
- **Racing Experience:** Minimum of one (1) year of competitive experience in a 360-sprint car and two (2) years of competitive experience in micro sprints, outlaw karts, restricted sprint classes, or equivalent.
- **Safety Record:** Documented history of safe competition with no pattern of reckless conduct or repeated incidents.
- **Insurance:** Must have no less than \$500,000 Personal Injury
- **Orientation:** Completion of a mandatory Series orientation covering procedures, expectations, and safety protocols.

3. Insurance & Legal Requirements

Participation is contingent upon approval by Skagit Speedways’ insurance carrier. The following documents must be completed and approved prior to any on-track activity:

- Minor Participant Waiver (signed by both parents/guardians).
- Indemnification and Hold-Harmless Agreement.
- Notarized parental signatures when required by the insurer.
- Proof of legal guardianship if only one parent is signing.
- Submission of a racing résumé, references, and prior competition documentation for underwriter review.

No Minor Driver may participate until Skagit Speedway receives written confirmation of insurance approval.

4. Equipment & Safety Standards

The Minor Driver must comply with all Skagit Speedway technical and safety rules, including:

- Properly fitted seat, belts, and head-and-neck restraint appropriate for the driver's size.
- Arm restraints and approved helmet meeting current standards.
- Car must meet all 410-sprint car technical specifications without exception.

Skagit Speedway reserves the right to require additional safety equipment for Minor Drivers.

5. Team & Supervision Requirements

- The Minor Driver must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all events.
- The team must designate a crew chief with a minimum of five (5) years of sprint car experience.
- Skagit Speedway may impose conduct standards on the team to ensure a safe environment.

6. Competition Restrictions

Skagit Speedway or its insurer may impose any of the following restrictions:

- Rear-of-field starts for initial events.
- Restrictions on feature participation until competency is demonstrated.
- Track size limitations (e.g., no half-mile tracks until further approval).
- Season-by-season renewal of eligibility.
- Immediate revocation of eligibility following any unsafe incident.

7. Authority & Revocation

Skagit Speedway retains full authority to approve, deny, suspend, or revoke a Minor Driver's eligibility at any time. Insurance approval may also be withdrawn at any time, resulting in immediate ineligibility.
